On Saturday March 27th, hours are from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm and there are concerts and workshops throughout the park and all the fun thrilling rides and attractions of Silver Dollar City. Plus, the big rally is held in Echo Hollow Amphitheatre at noon, 3:00 and 6:00 pm with speaker Doug Compton and music from Lincoln Brewster. On March 28th, Sunday Worship Services are at 8:30 and 11:00 in Echo Hollow and feature music by 33 Miles and speaker Joe White of Kanakuk Kamps, plus the park is open for fun from 9:00 am - 6:00 pm.
