You might want to check out the new Lantern Light Tours (there is a minimal fee for this tour)...you'll step back in time and experience Marvel Cave just as the early explorers did - by lantern light! This unique tour is limited to 20 guests per day. Reservations are needed and kids need to be at least eight years old to join the group.
